READ MOSIAH 4:1-2

Compare these verses to Moses 1:10. Why would it be good for us to realize that “man is nothing”?

READ MOSIAH 4:3

How can Christ give His forgiveness and grace to a whole people all at once? How does this work with what you know about Zion, especially learning that “to see eye to eye” means seeing eye to eye with God, not your neighbor.

What happens when everyone in a community sees eye to eye with God?

READ MOSIAH 4:4

Can you be a disciple of Christ without keeping His commandments? Why do some believers think this is possible?

READ MOSIAH 4:12

What is the difference between growing in the knowledge of the gospel and growing in the knowledge of God’s glory? What else does verse 12 say that could help answer this question?

READ MOSIAH 4:14-15

What would the world be like if more children had the guidance of righteous parents? Which social ills are the result of a lack of good parenting or the absence of mentors to teach young people right and wrong?

READ MOSIAH 4:16-26

How can we become the type of people mentioned in these verses? What was the worst sin of those in Sodom and how does it relate to these teachings?



READ MOSIAH 5:1-2

How would a prophet today find out if the people believed in his words? How did King Benjamin's people respond?

Give some other examples of times in the scriptures where people had a sudden change of heart. Can this process happen gradually? Have you experienced this?

READ MOSIAH 5:9

Have you taken the name of Christ upon yourself? What does it mean to be a "saint"?
