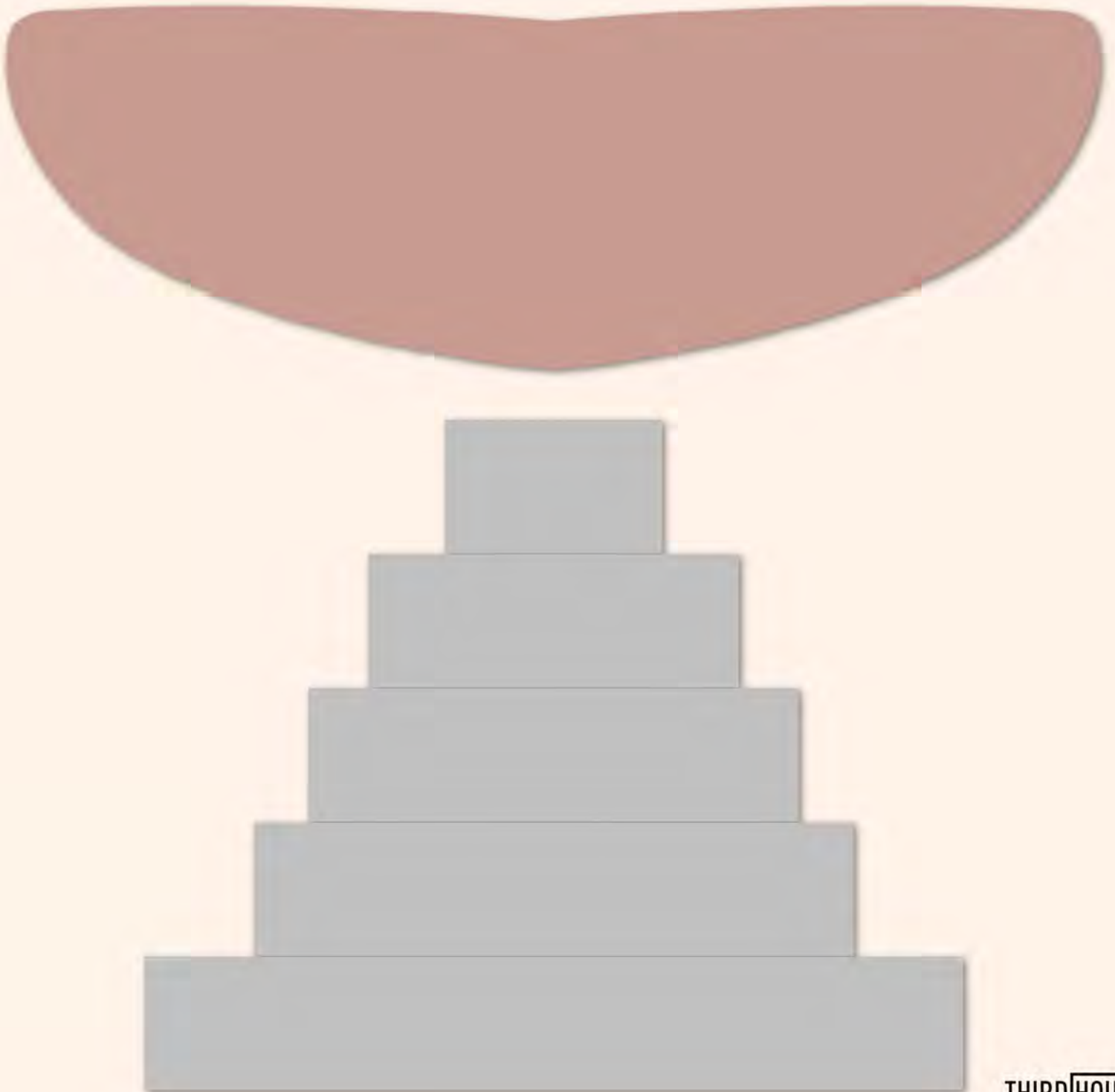


Barge vs. Babel

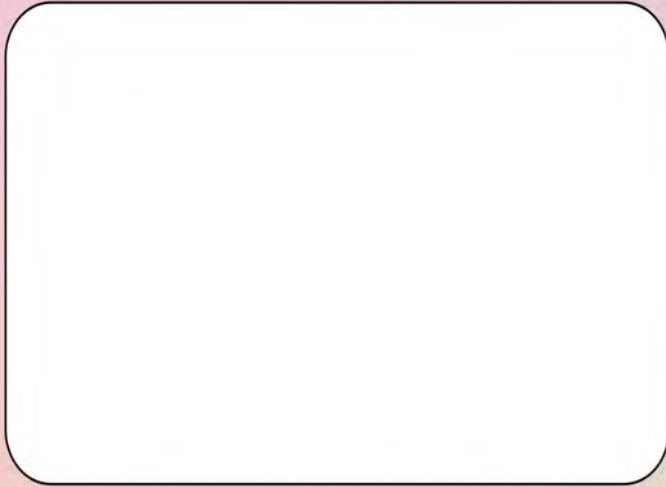

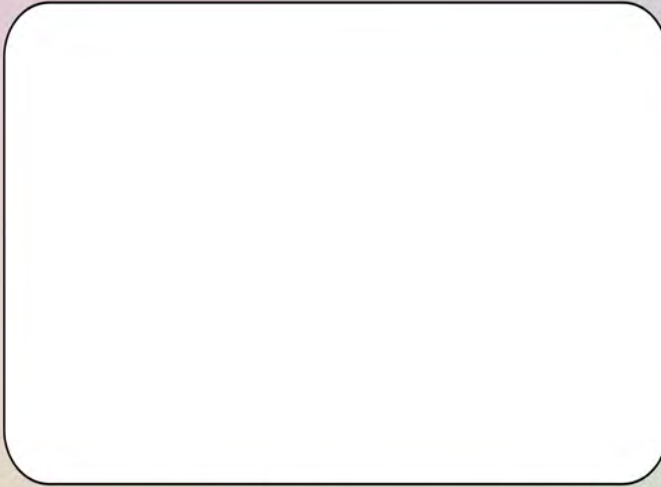

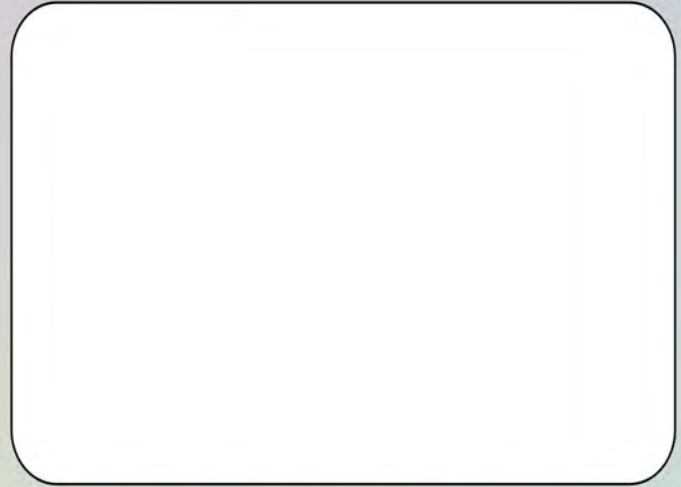
Illustrate the Story of the Jaredites
